Coronavirus (COVID-19) Catch-up Premium – Statement of Planned Expenditure

<p>Total amount of premium: £17.947 (estimate)</p>
<p>How the fund will be spent:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Increasing of teaching capacity through appointment of two part time teachers. One in KS1 and the other in KS2 Purchase of additional curriculum resources
<p>How the impact of the fund on education attainment will be assessed?</p> <p>When returning to school pupils are assessed and identified as needing catch up. Those children who work below age related expectations or the children who require a 'booster class' to move from developing to secure.</p> <p>Gaps were identified in writing and phonics.</p>
<p>Pupils will be assessed periodically to check that they are making up lost ground. Assessments will take the form of teacher assessment against NC criteria; ongoing formative assessments; in-school strategies to support the ongoing assessment of recall and retention; as well as formal summative testing at the end of every term.</p>
<p>Class teachers deliver some targeted interventions across school. In addition to this, increased support staff will allow for the release of class teachers to deliver additional interventions across school. Groups of children who have been identified as having gaps in knowledge in English will complete interventions, in addition to receiving quality first teaching from their class teacher, to work on specific targets. Where necessary, class teachers will liaise with TAs and monitor pupil's work within each intervention to continually assess progress. At each half term point, interventions will be reviewed, alongside teacher assessment to determine progress made and next steps.</p>
