Understanding the World

Children will explore and discuss their own immediate environment. They will learn about changes as they grow up. They will also explore the 5 senses.

Expressive Arts and Design

Literacy

We will be looking at our individual names, practising writing them correctly. The children will begin to recognise some letters, learning words that contain these letters and how to write them correctly.

Children will be able to talk about stories in their own words and have the opportunity to recognise some sight vocabulary words.

In school children will read each week. We begin with discussion books and move on to phonic books as they are ready. Please read books at home with your child- a love for reading is so important!

Mathematics

This half term we will be doing a lot of counting and number recognition. The children will learn some mathematical concepts such as biggest, tallest, sequencing and sorting and matching pairs.
