English

In English we will be basing our writing on 'The Manchester Ridgeback Dragon' (Pie Corbett) and the text 'Flat Stanley'.

Phonics- We will continue with Phonics sessions to consolidate sounds.

Spellings- We will continue to look at Year 2 spelling strategies including contractions with apostrophes, suffixes -tion and -ly and homophones. See our class page for spelling lists. Common exception words will also be taught and revisited.

Handwriting will be taught once a week.

In Maths the children will be learning:

- Money (adding and giving change)
- Time – focusing on quarter past, quarter to and working on telling the time to 5 minutes.
- Measurement- Capacity and weight.

Homework

Homework will be handed out on a **Friday**, This needs to be completed by **Wednesday**. You are also free to complete any of the optional homework linked to our topic.

The Coast

Geography – We will be looking at the physical and human features of coastal environments. This will include mapwork (including finding out about their symbols), and planning routes using compass directions.

Computing – We will be searching for information on the internet and presenting the data in different ways.

R.E. – We will be finding out about our local faith communities.

Reading

Children will take part in regular reading activities throughout the week including guided reading activities. Please make sure that reading books and PACT books come into school **every day**.

PE – Will continue to be on a **Tuesday (2Y) & Wednesday (2A)**.

We will be learning about some different aspects of Athletics as well developing our striking and fielding skills.

Music – Myths and Legends: Children will create rhythms and arrange them in a particular order or structure. They will explore ways of writing down different textural layers and perform compositions accurately, following the structure score.

DT – We will research, plan and make our own pizzas. Children will learn where different foods come from, taste different flavours and understand the importance of hygiene.

PSHE – Children will explore growing and changing and their feelings around moving class or year. We will also cover safety in different environments; risk and safety at home and emergencies.
