In Maths the children will be working on:

- Number, place value and calculation, using all 4 operations and problem solving.
- Measurement, including
- conversions, area and perimeter.
- Geometry with 2 and 3 d shapes, including angles and parts of a circle.
- Statistics pie charts and line graphs and finding the mean.
- Using & applying their knowledge.

In Science the children will learning about 'Light' and exploring:

- How light travels
- How humans see
- · How we see colour
- Manipulating shadows

PE: We will be learning the skills and tactics needed to play tennis. 6F- Monday PE 6R-Friday P.E

PSHE: Relationships: We will be exploring families, friendships, safe relationships and how to protect ourselves and others.

RE: Islam - What does it mean to be a Muslim in British society today?

French: We will be starting our new French units, beginning with 'French History'.

Computing: Digital Safety and Online Safety - Exploring well-being, privacy and security, online identity, relationships, communication and the media.



Through a range of cross curricular activities incorporating History and Geography, we will be exploring the key question:

How was Britain able to stand firm against the German threat?

In Art lessons, we will be exploring silhouette and perspective, and creating cityscapes.

In Music lessons, we will be exploring the most popular UK music from WW2, and performing some well-known songs from the era.

In English children will be:

Focusing on the novels 'Goodnight Mister Tom' and 'After the War'. We will read and analyse the narratives before using them as inspiration for our own narrative writing. We will also be writing a biography of one of the key characters. Throughout, we will work on Year 6 spelling and grammar
