Year 1 - Summer 2

History

Children will take a step back in time to look at the 60's lifestyle and how it compares to our lives today. They explore music and clothing around at that time.



RE

In RE , we will be focussing on the Old Testament and Jewish scriptures. Children will think about their morals and messages.

English

Children will consolidate their previous learning of phase 3, 4 & 5 phonics. They will continue to learn alternative sounds and begin to apply these sounds in their writing. We will focus on consistent use of sentence structure including finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Children will be looking at 'The Little Wooden Robot and the Log Princess' and write narrative stories inspired by the characters and settings. Children will continue to develop their handwriting and presentation, focusing on letter joins.

Children will complete their Phonics Screening Check during the week of Monday 8th—Friday 12th June.

Music

Children will extend their knowledge of musical vocabulary with the theme of *Under the Sea*

Mathematics

In Maths we will be:

- Recapping addition and subtraction, and how to identify inverse operations.
- Solving one step problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Comparing, describing and solving word problems.

PSHE

Children will look at '*Growing and Changing*'. They will understand what makes them unique and how to manage feelings when things go wrong. They will also look at how to keep safe and the rules and age restrictions which look after us.

Design Technology

Children will design and make a mini raft inspired by the book 'The Little Wooden Robot and the Log Princess.' They will develop their woodwork skills including sawing and joining.

Reading and Homework

Children will take part in regular reading activities throughout the week. They will also be read with individually. Please make sure books are brought into school **every day**. Reading books are changed on Fridays. Homework will be set on a Friday and is to be returned by the following Wednesday, completed in **pencil and neatly!**
