Our year 5 topic this half term is based on historic crime and punishment.

In English this half term we will be looking at historical texts - more specifically focusing on William Shakespeare's work. We will be researching his different contributions to literature before focusing in on Romeo and Juliet, then the gruesome tale of Macbeth!

Throughout this half term we will continue to teach SPAG and complete Big Writes linked with our English work.

In Maths we will continue to revisit everything we have done this year and work on our reasoning skills. We will look at all formal methods for our calculations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will recap shape, measures and fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also revisit time.

We will continue to test children for times table knowledge and written arithmetic.

In science we will be learning all about animals including humans and looking to describe the changes a human goes through as they develop to old age.

In history we will be looking at crime and punishment through the eras. The children will look at the different types of trials, crimes and punishments that took place in different historical periods.
