



This half term our topic is:

## Digging up the Past



In our **Maths** lessons we will learn to:

- \*Recognise the place value of digits in 3 digit numbers
- \*Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numbers and words
- \*To recap maths used for addition and subtraction and introduce new methods.
- \*Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- \*Time

In our **History** lessons, we will be learning;

- \* Where the Stone Age appears on the timeline.
- \* How people lived (hunters gathering for food, houses, weapons)
- \* How the Stone Age compares to today and how artefacts are used as evidence
- \* Changes and comparisons between the Bronze and Iron Age

In **Science** lessons we will be studying rocks and soil:

- \* Comparing and grouping together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- \* Describing in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock
- \* Recognising that soils are made from rocks and organic matter

**Computing:** Online safety, Digital Imagery

**French:** Where is France? Numbers & Alphabet

**PE:** Netball and Swimming

**Art:** Prehistoric Paintings

**PSHE:** Families and Friendships

**RE:** Hinduism

**Music:** Ballads

In our **English** lessons we will also be identifying and creating instructions based on the text 'How to wash a Woolly Mammoth'. The children will be comparing and evaluating the effectiveness of instructions, listening and following instructions as well as write their own set of instructions

In English we will be looking at: Adventure and Mystery, with a focus on our class text, 'The Abominables' by Eva Ibbotson. The children will be looking at the way the story uses the plot to create atmosphere and the way the author has structured the plot to create suspense
