At Bailey Green we have always given the children opportunities to go away on residential visits in all year groups in KS2, and we are aiming to re-start these again in the next academic year (2022-2023). We believe that the opportunity to work independently when away from home is invaluable and the children gain so many social skills, as well as learning academically supporting what they learn in school.

Residential visits provide experiences that we can't offer in school, such as canoeing, caving and abseiling. The children participate in team-building activities, develop stronger peer relationships and grow massively in confidence. We always use North Tyneside approved school travel companies and fully risk assess each visit.

We appreciate that there is considerable cost involved in allowing your child to go on a residential trip, so we do not expect all children to go on any or every trip, although some do. Once a deposit is paid we set up a payment system for anyone who would rather spread the cost of the visit over several months.
