# PE

## Computing

Children will continue to develop their basic skills in typing and logging in. They will learn how to be safe on a computer and continue to create Digital Art.

# Art

Children will be able to name the primary colours and explore coloured materials to mix secondary colours. Children will mix primary colours to make secondary colours. New skills will be applied to a final piece.

# PΕ

Floor Gymnastics. Children will develop their balance, agility and coordination through gymnastic skills.

# RE

This half term we will be focussing on the Christmas Story and the Birth of Jesus and Why are gifts given at Christmas?

This half term our Year 1 topic is History! Children will learn about The Great Fire of Newcastle and compare it to The Great Fire of London.

# **English**

Children will continue their learning of phase 3 phonics along with Phase 4 and 5 sounds. Children will use their phonological knowledge to segment and blend words for both reading and writing. Children will write for a variety of purposes including diary writing as well as information texts. Children will continue to bring a PACT book home and should be in school everday.

## **Mathematics**

Children will continue to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will begin to double and half numbers, introduce terminology of multiplication and division and work on problem solving questions. Children will also investigate money, and time and the use of positional direction.

#### **PSHE**

This half term we will celebrate Anti-Bullying Week and the importance of being different. We will also look at respecting ourselves and others.

# Science

In Science, children will be observing the changes which occur with plants from Autumn to Winter. The children will also gain an understanding of the differing weathers from Autumn to Winter.

# Music

Children will begin to develop an understanding of dynamics and tempo. They will begin to recognise the basic tempo and understand how pitch changes in individual pieces.
