## In English we will be:

## In Maths the children will be extending their knowledge of...

- Measures: time, area and perimeter, volume
- Fractions: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions, working with decimals and exploring fractions, decimals and percentage equivalents
   We will continue to work on our mental strategies and arithmetic skills.

## In Science we will be learning about 'Electricity'.

We will:

- Revise electrical safety.
- Look at how the voltage in a cell affects the brightness of a bulb or loudness of a buzzer.
- Use electrical symbols to represent a circuit.
- Compare how the function of the components in a circuit can vary.
